



**CANADIAN REGISTRATION BOARD OF OCCUPATIONAL HYGIENISTS

ROHT Eligibility

ROHT registration is by examination only. Eligibility requirements for admission to the examination are:

1. Five years experience in occupational hygiene or related experience subsequent to receipt of a high school diploma.
 - Completion of a community college occupational hygiene technology program may be accepted as equivalent to up to 2 years experience.
 - Completion of a community college program in a related science or engineering field may be accepted as equivalent to up to 1 year of experience.
 - Completion of an equivalent of 2 years of a university undergraduate program of related sciences or engineering courses may be accepted as equivalent to up to 1 year of experience.
2. More than 50% of each year for which credit is claimed must have been spent in occupational hygiene or closely related activities. The applicant must be engaged in occupational hygiene activities at the time the application is submitted. Two references from ROHs or ROHTs or other suitably accredited persons such as CIH, CRSP, CSP must be provided.
