## ROHT Eligibility

ROHT registration is by examination only. Eligibility requirements for admission to the examination are:

All candidates for ROHT must possess as a minimum

- a college degree,
- a certificate or diploma indicating successful completion of a course of studies in occupational hygiene, occupational health & safety, or
- a related science or engineering; or completion of two years of study at the university level in a related science or engineering.

In addition to possession of a certificate or diploma, the following minimum experience standards apply for all ROHT candidates:

Academic Qualification	Professional Experience
3 year program, diploma (occupational hygiene or equivalent)	3 years
3 year program, diploma (acceptable science or engineering)	4 years
2 year program, diploma (occupational hygiene or equivalent)	4 years
2 year program, diploma (acceptable science or engineering)	5 years
1 year program, certificate (occupational hygiene or equivalent)	5 years
1 year program, certificate (acceptable science or engineering)	6 years
Completion 2 years university program in acceptable science or engineering	5 years

- More than 50% of each year for which credit is claimed must have been spent in occupational hygiene or closely related activities.
- The applicant must be engaged in occupational hygiene activities at the time the application is submitted.
- Two professional references based on the candidate's occupational hygiene work from ROHs or ROHTs or other suitably accredited persons such as CIH, CRSP, CSP must be provided.
